On July 3rd, the Inter-American Court of Human Rights is releasing its long-awaited Advisory Opinion on the Climate Emergency and Human Rights, a landmark development that is expected to define binding standards for states' climate obligations under international human rights law.

The first session of this series will feature initial reactions and expert analysis from leading voices in environmental law, climate justice, and human rights, with a focus on what this Advisory Opinion means for strategic litigation, legal enforcement, & vulnerable communities in the region and beyond.
